



## Application for the UMM Scholarships 2009 – Terms and Conditions

We invite students writing a thesis on a microfinance-related topic to participate in the “University Meets Microfinance” - Scholarship Programme.

The scholarships will be awarded for field research conducted in the frame of a Master or equivalent programme by students from universities in the European Union. Scholarships of up to 1500 EUR will be granted, depending on the student’s field research proposal. Participating students may get additional assistance in organizing the field research. The student is required to provide a provisional budget with his / her application. The student will receive 60% of the Scholarship once he/she is selected and the remaining 40% upon reception of a 2-page report on the field research, which includes the timetable, a description of the project and results. Furthermore, the student shall submit receipts of his/her travel expenses (boarding passes, proof of payment for accomodation).

It would be highly appreciated if the student could share the results of the research during one of the workshops or awareness events organized by the UMM programme.

Students are welcome to submit their research proposal to [umm@planetfinance.org](mailto:umm@planetfinance.org) by the following dates:

July 15<sup>th</sup> 2009 and

October 31<sup>st</sup> 2009.

Selected participants for the Scholarship programme will be informed four weeks after submission deadline.

The application shall include the following documents:

- Research Proposal (5 pages maximum – preferably in English):
  - a) Research outline and structure
  - b) Explanation of the methodology
  - c) Short literature review
  - d) Tentative timetable
  - e) Theoretical background
  - f) Provisional budget for the field expenses
- Short CV
- Application Form (Appendix I)
- Declaration of Consent (Appendix II)
- Declaration of Acceptance from the supervising professor and/or tutor (Appendix III)

It is recommended to write the thesis in English. If the thesis is written in another language, the students will need to provide a short abstract of their results in English.
